Step 1: Verify Eligibility

Effective October 1, 2010, the Program offers a rebate of 60% of the actual installed cost, up to \$850 for qualified attic insulation. Read the complete list of eligibility requirements on the other side of this application to ensure that your installation is eligible for Program rebates. If you meet requirements, **please complete Steps 2 and 3 below, and mail all documentation to the address on the left.**

This Program is subject to change and may end without prior notice.

Please allow approximately 12 weeks for your completed application to be processed. Incomplete applications cannot be processed.

Contractors are eligible to have the rebate signed over to them.

Contractors receiving rebates are not eligible for any other incentives for the same products. Contractors must submit hard copy application (no online application).

Tenants must include written permission from the property owner granting permission to install the measure(s).

Rebate incentives may not exceed 60% of the actual installed cost, up to \$850, and the cost of the energy efficient product. The only costs eligible for incentives are: materials, equipment, and labor.

Failure to complete the table and provide required supporting documents will either delay the payment process or result in your application being denied.

All measure installations are subject to verification inspection by the Program Administrator or third party agent to ensure that the insulation is installed per Program requirements.

The Company, EGIA (rebate processor), Governance Board Members, Contract and Program Administrator disclaim any and all liability, loss or damage related to:

- ⇒ participation in the Program, including use or installation of the measure;
- ⇒ loss or delay of rebate check in the mail; and
- ⇒ any taxes that may be imposed as a result of participation in the Program.

***Please note:** While spray foam is an efficient material for insulation, it can often seal your home in such a way that may reduce ventilation. Adequate levels of fresh air are required to maintain proper indoor air quality. While sealing a home too tightly with insulation is unlikely in most older homes, it is critical to follow proper safety practices. When using spray foam:

- If contractor-installed, contractor must conduct a pre/post installation measurement of ventilation to ensure adequate ventilation.
- If self-installed, you may wish to have a contractor measure the post-installation ventilation. You must have an operable carbon monoxide detector in the home.

The Program is not liable for any complications or health risks due to the installation of spray foam insulation.

Qualifications:

You are only eligible for a rebate if you:

- Are a Residential Customer (Service Classification No. 1) of Peoples Gas (the Company). Note: Commercial customers on Service Classification No. 2 are not eligible for residential rebates and must use the non-residential rebate application.
- Installed qualifying products in a residential dwelling.
- Purchased qualifying equipment new at retail price.

Your installation of attic insulation is only eligible for a rebate if it is:

- Purchased and installed between July 1, 2010 - May 31, 2011.
- Installed prior to submittal of this application at the address listed on the application.
- Installed between heated and unheated spaces.
- New material that meets or exceeds all applicable local, state and federal standards.
- Installed following manufacturer's requirements.
- Installed throughout the entire attic.
- Final insulation level must be R-38 or greater.
- If pre-existing insulation is present, must indicate in table above.
- Final insulation level for crawl spaces with less than 24 inches between the bottom of the roof rafter and the top of the attic joists must be at least R-19.

If rebate is to be paid directly to the installing contractor, contractor must submit:

- Copy of customer job order/invoice showing rebate amount, signed by customer.
- All applicable purchase invoices.
- Signed customer application verifying product(s) installed.

Offer is valid from July 1, 2010 - May 31, 2011, or until funds are depleted, whichever comes first.

To be considered complete and eligible for rebates, all applications must:

- Be postmarked no later than 60 days after the purchase date, or by June 30, 2011, whichever comes first.
- Be limited to one rebate of each qualified product per customer per Program cycle (current Program cycle = December 2008 – May 2011).
- Include proof of purchase receipts, work orders or other documentation consisting of:
 - An itemized description of the product, including purchase price and purchase date.
 - Original R Value installed and final R Value (post-installation), total square footage of the space insulated, and all of the additional questions contained in the table above.
 - Professional contractor's name, business license number, phone number, address, product cost and installation cost (if product was installed by a contractor).
 - Invoice showing balance due of zero, paid in full stamp, or payment terms of finance agreement.

If you are applying for a rebate for a residence you own, but the gas account number is in your tenant's name, you must supply the following information:

- Copy of customer job order/invoice showing rebate amount, signed by customer.
- All applicable purchase invoices.
- Signed customer application verifying product(s) installed.

Online applications must:

- Be accompanied by a copy of sales receipt and online confirmation page, submitted to the address on the front side of this application.
